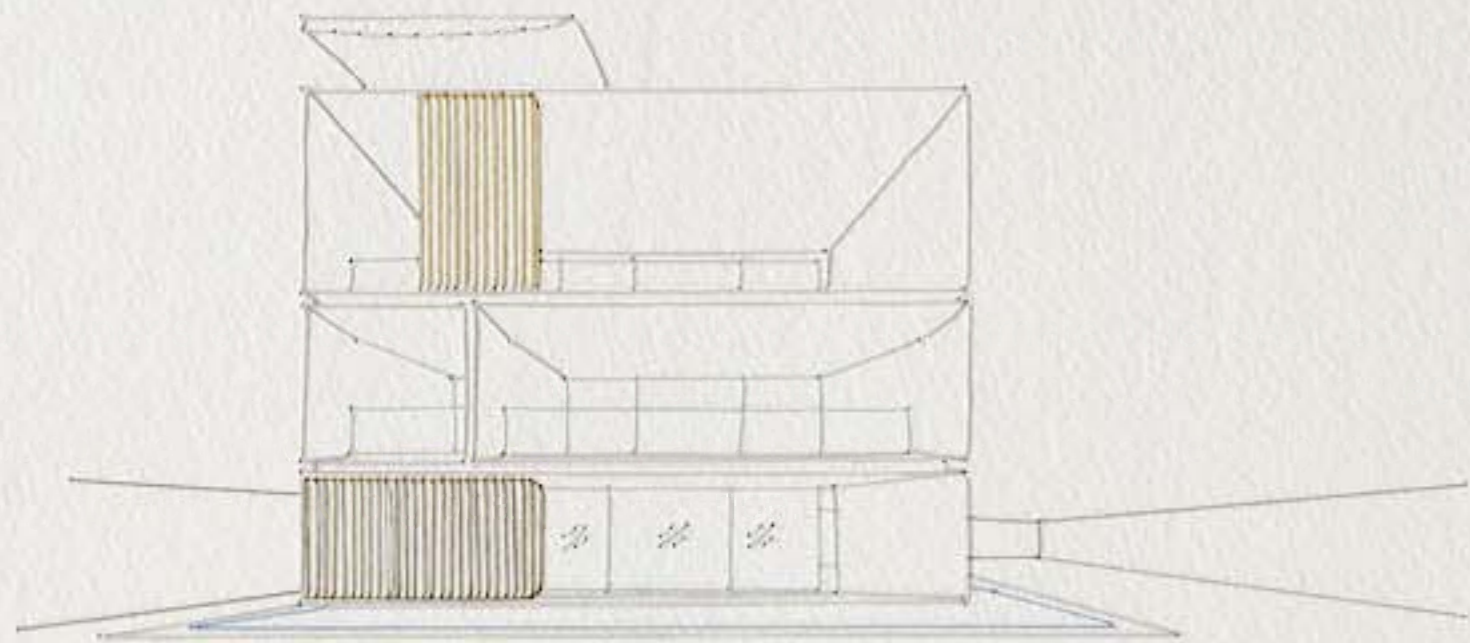

# Wallpaper's Architects Directory 2012

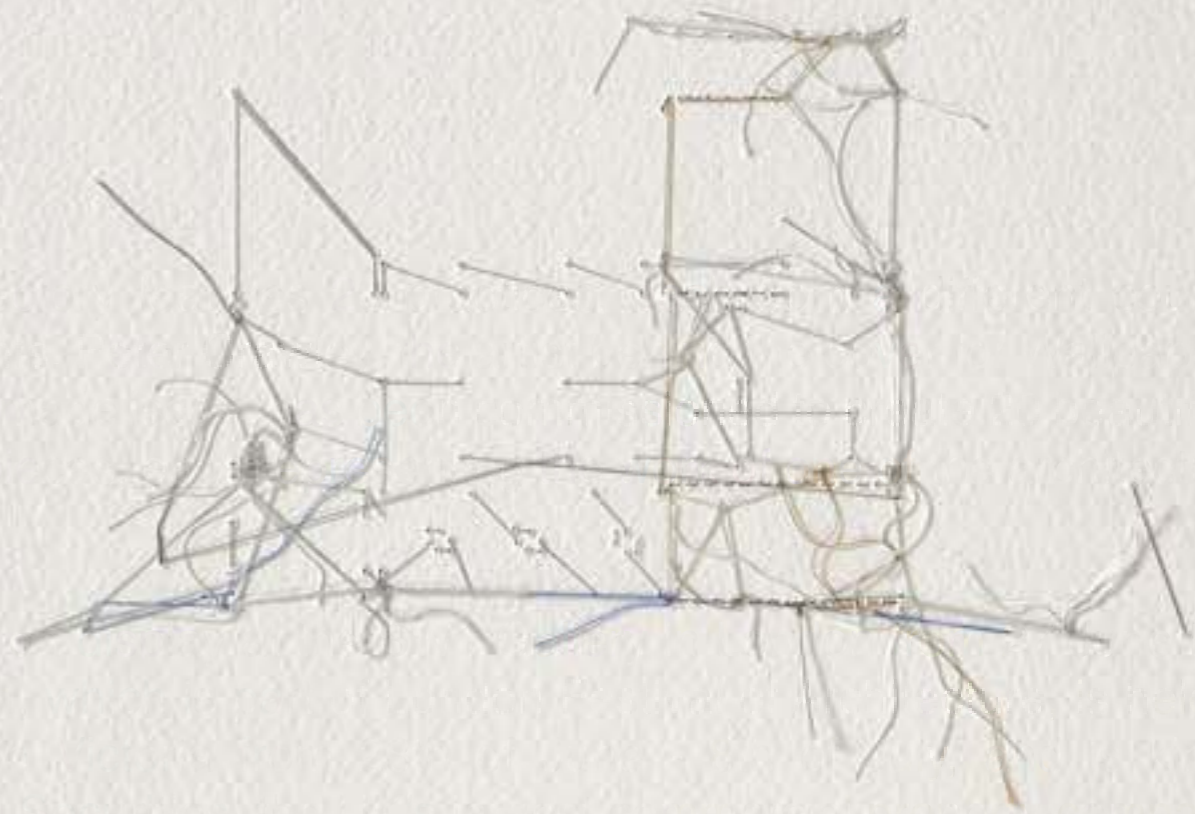
Wallpaper's annual Architects Directory is the ultimate little black book of new architectural talent. Featuring a selection of up-and-coming architects from around the world, it is an eagerly awaited snapshot of emerging young talent, bringing new work to global prominence.

This year, the directory features 20 practices, each from a different country across six continents. Peter Crawley, the artist behind the cover for Wallpaper's August 2011 Handmade issue, has been commissioned to create 20 beautifully hand-stitched art pieces, each representing the work of one of the architectural practices.

The pieces will be on display at the SW1 Gallery in London from 27 June to 7 July. The exhibition, which is part of London Festival of Architecture, is held at the SW1 gallery in Victoria from 28th of June - 8th of July, and is kindly supported by Land Securities, the UK's largest commercial property company.

Jacopo Mascheroni studied in Italy, France and the US, eventually joining Richard Meier's atelier in New York. In 2005, he moved back to Italy and set up JM Architecture in Milan. Inspired by everything from fashion to films to car design, the practice's output focuses on residential projects, including this villa in Bolzano, Italy. 'We pay meticulous attention to details, finishes and materials,' says Mascheroni, to achieve 'simplicity, coherence, clarity and harmony.' The result is a detached, other-worldly feel; minimalism fused with geometric forms.
